About CCIA



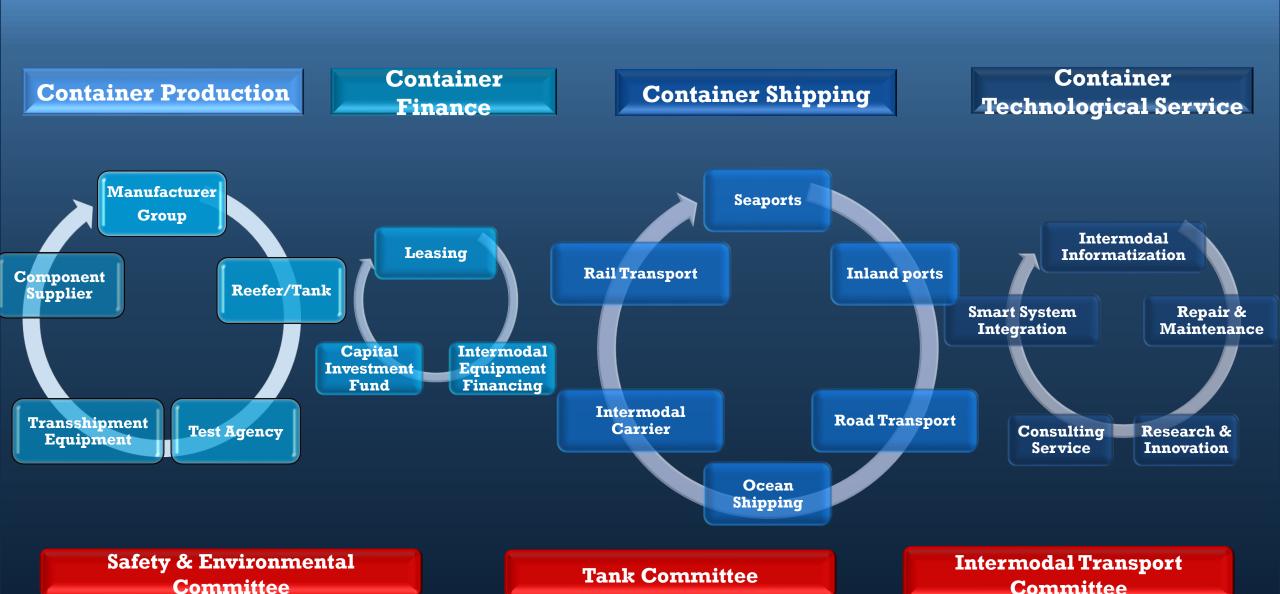
- by the MOT of the People's Republic of China.

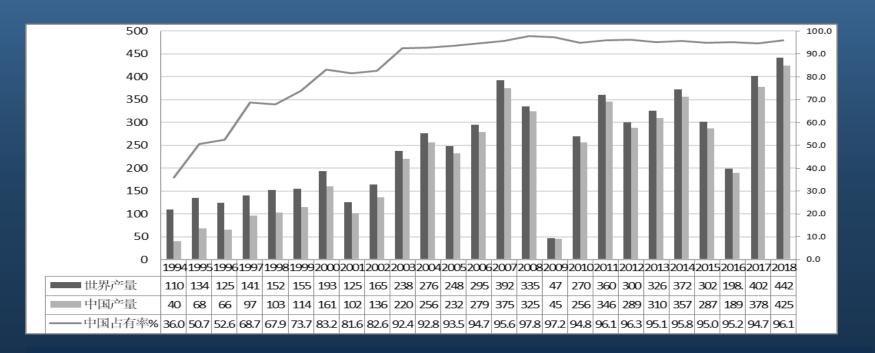

China Container Industry Development & Trend



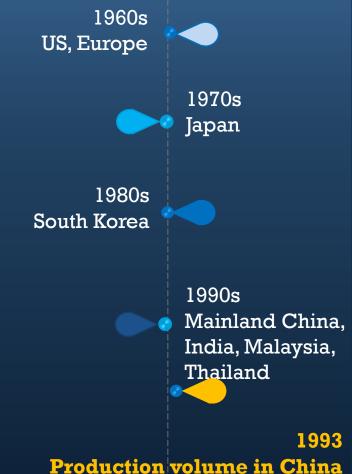
ranked the 1st

Production & Sales in China rank 1st of the world for 26 yrs



- China is upgrading to be a container and related equipment manufacturing power instead of simply production volume concentrated. The industry will still be an oligopoly market.
- Container manufacturers in China have the world's leading production capacity. In 2018, its container production volume broke the historic record with 4.25 million TEU, increased by 12 percent comparing to 2017, and the market share reached to 96.1 percent.

Timeline of Container Production center moving

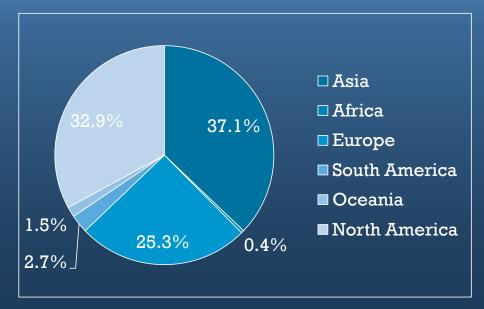


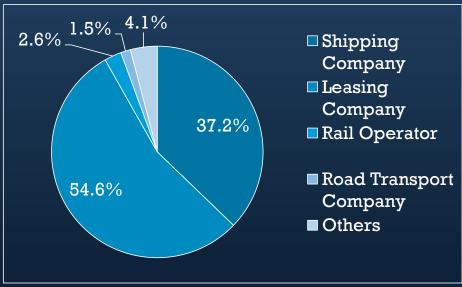
China Container Industry DEV. & Trend - Market



- Most of the containers produced in China are exported to oversea markets. Over 90 percent of the container sales are out of China market.
- In 2018, China exported 3.34 million containers (with pallet box included), the value is about 10.36 billion US\$. The amount and the value were increased by 11.5 and 23.2 percent. However, production and sales in 2019 dropped heavily.



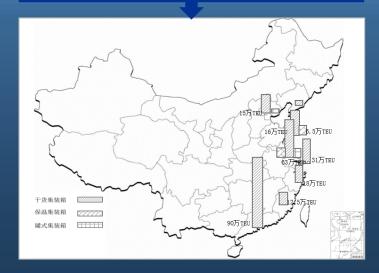

Niche Market Will Expand

 Market potential of reefer and tank will be great. Reefer container for both road and rail transportation will grow with cold chain logistics and intermodal transport develop.



Green Production Remains Vital

 To meet the requirements of national environmental policy, water-borne coating has been fully used in container production since April 1st, 2017 to replace oil-base coating.



Domestic Sales Grow

Demand from domestic market keeps expand due to the greater attention to intermodal transport.

China Intermodal Trend-Rail-Water Breaks Records



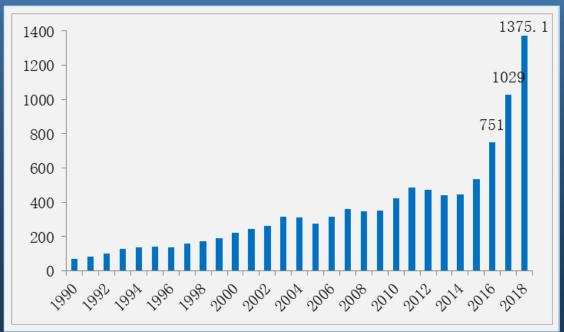
In 2018, containers by rail-water intermodal way in major ports of China reached to 4.5 million TEU, with an increase of 29.4 percent, accounting for 1.8 percent of those ports handling capacity. Average increase rate arrived to 27.8 percent for recent 5 years, which is higher than the setting target of 10 percent in related policy.



China Intermodal Trend-Container Shipped by Rail Grows







In 2018, tonnage of freight dispatched by rail is 4.026 billion, with an increase of 0.337 billion and 9.1 percent. The transportation of container, vehicle and express good have increased by 44.6%, 25.1% and 2.3%.

■ In 2018, containers dispatched by rail is 13.75 million TEU, with and increase of 33.4%. It has been the third year that the increase rate is above 30%.

China Intermodal Trend-China Railway Express Rises



- Railway China (CR) Express to Europe has developed for 8 years, with performance 18,000 of servicing trains. 59 cities in China have built connections with 49 cities in Europe from 15 countries. Now 65 CR **Express** routes have been developed.
- Cargo range is expanding. Under the administration of CR Express Coordination Committee, operators pays more attention to service quality. Brand effect is obvious.

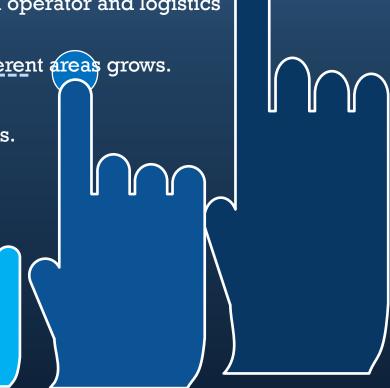

Global Logistics Corridor Change Driven by B&R

From maritime-centered to land-sea combined

Traditional corridor focused on the Eastern China and are mainly horizontal. The development of CR express moves the center to the west part. Now southern area is rising. The corridor network is forming, which expands the openness of west part of China and reducing the economic dependency on natural resources.

New Logistics Corridor Drives Economy Development

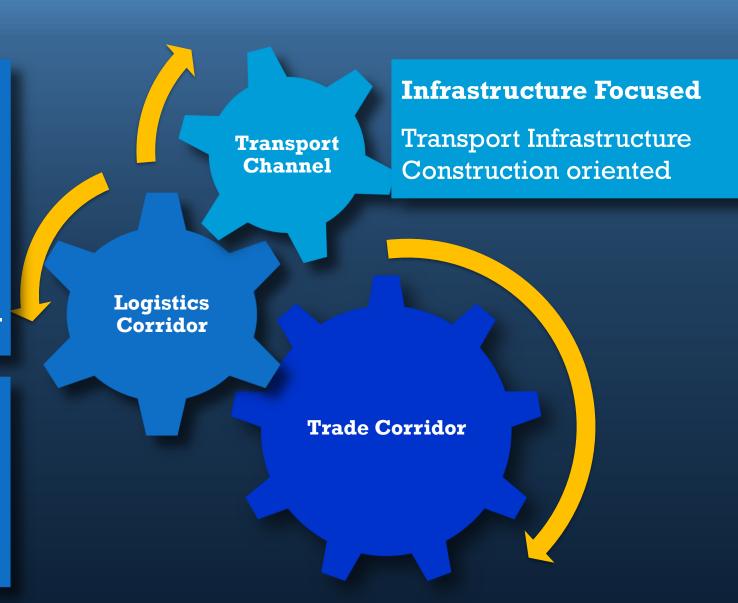


Infrastructure & Network

Logistics network and elements integration concentrated, mainly achieve networking of transport channels and normalizing of transport operation, in order to build intermodal system to provide service.

Infrastructure & Network & Trade

Hub develops with the integration of supply chain links, and improvement of trade facilitation level. Supply chain is reconstructed based on corridor route and hub distribution.

- Logistics companies make a significant contribution to regional financial revenue

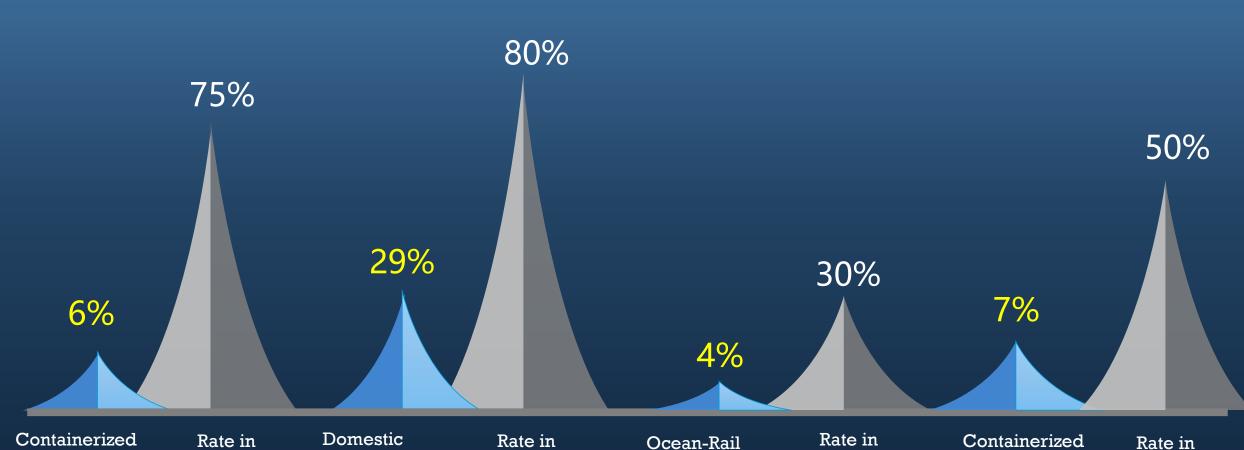
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- Goods and Materials flow promotes trade, RDC cluster forms
